a	Hardscape/accessories used to enhance the design, not to overwhelm, dictate, or distract. (June only)
b	Overall construction and scale of each design element in relation with plot shape and size.
c	Endurance and longevity of design elements and continued appropriateness and effectiveness.
3. Horticultur	al elements: total category points awarded
a	Sun/shade appropriateness of plant selections.
b	Variety and creativity in use of plant materials selected for the design.
c	Use of interesting color combinations, sizes, textures, and height variations.
d	Required elements: 1) colorful perennials, 2) colorful annuals, 3) at least one herb, 4) a bush or shrub, 5) at least one fruit or vegetable. (June only)
4. Maintenar	nce: total category points awarded
a	Ivy trimming
b	Weeding and deadheading
c	Watering (especially containers, pots, and water features).
d	Overall upkeep and maintained appearance (exclusive of design).
